GETTING YOUR CHAPTER OFF THE GROUND

STEP 1

Recruit fellow students to form a committee

The committee leads on organising events and activities on behalf of the Chapter.

A Chapter needs at least 3 people in the committee; President, Treasurer and Secretary. You should also consider what other roles are needed, such as a Social Secretary and Outreach Officer.

STEP 2

Introduce the committee members to Engineers Without Borders UK

Once you've identified the committee members, tell us who they are. We'll share resources and news with the whole committee so no one misses out.

STEP 3

Complete Engineers Without Borders UK affiliation agreement

STEP 4

Get registered with your Students Union

Speak to your SU about the registration process for new societies. This usually includes completing some paperwork, the Engineers Without Borders UK team can support with this.

Once you're registered, the SU should be able to support you with hosting your Chapter events and promotion. Speak to the SU team to find out what support is offered at your university.

Once you've completed these steps, you'll be provided a bespoke Engineers Without Borders UK logo for your Chapter. We'll also set up a unique email account to manage your activities and a webpage on our website.

Next you can start to consider how to market yourselves and engage members through events! Consider setting up social media pages to advertise your events.
